Election year is upon us. Boykins Councilmembers and Mayor

serve a two-year term. Recent changes in State Code have regulated that local elections no longer be held in May. They are to be included with the General Election in November. This change extends our current local officials' terms by 6 months. Instead of ending June 30, terms will end December  $31^{st}$ .
